

Minutes of a continued meeting of the Saltville Town Council held on Tuesday, March 18, 2008 at 7:00 P.M., at the Town Hall. This continuation was from the regularly scheduled meeting that was recessed on Tuesday, March 11, 2008.

Mayor Campbell called the meeting back to order and stated, the intentions was to approve the bids for the Downtown Project.

Steven Johnson said the engineer has requested one more week because some changes to the plans were made. Mr. Johnson stated the bids will be opened next Monday, March 24, 2008 at 2:00 P.M. at the Town Hall. If possible, Mr. Johnson requested a Special Called meeting on Tuesday, March 25, 2008 at 7:00 P.M.

Steven Johnson stated he was a little confused on advertising and getting the mowing bid, especially the acreage.

Councilman Maiden made a motion to rescind the bids and continue with the Inmates performing this task. Councilman Young seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Steven Johnson stated the mowing contract at the Elizabeth Cemetery needed to be put out for bid proposals.

Jeff Smith stated that this contract is from the first of April through October 31st of each year.

Councilman Maiden made a motion to advertise for mowing bid proposals for the cemetery. Councilman Palmer seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Councilman Johnson told Council he had a request from Robert Duncan to hook to the Towns water supply during the upcoming Bike Virginia Event at the Palmer Mill.

Motion passed unanimously to add this request to the agenda.

Councilman Palmer made a motion to direct the Director of Public Works to investigate the feasibility to move forward with this request. Councilman Orr seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
