Old Business

1. Town-wide mowing

There was one bid in the amount of \$8500. It was from Danny Hanshew and included using his own equipment. Clerk/Treasurer Steve Johnson said that amount was for the rest of the mowing season and not on a per-month basis. Councilwoman Johnson asked if Mr. Hanshew had a copy of the mowing list, and Mr. Johnson said he had been given a copy.

Councilman Robinson asked if there would be a contract for Mr. Hanshew or who would be responsible for making sure the mowing is done properly, otherwise. Police Chief Erik Puckett said he would go over the list with Mr. Hanshew, and based on how the inmates mowed, would instruct him on what to mow every week or two weeks. Councilwoman Johnson said she would like to see everything on the list mowed now to get everything in order and then go to that schedule that Chief Puckett mentioned. Councilman Morris said he hoped Mr. Hanshew knew what he was getting into since the town has a lot to mow, and Mr. Johnson replied the town would just prorate what to pay him if he decided he didn't want to do it after all. Councilman Robinson asked why the town mowed the Lions Club property since that property wasn't owned by the town, and Councilman Morris said the inmates have always mowed it since the carnival brings people into the town.

Councilman Eugene Call made a motion to accept Mr. Hanshew's bid, and Councilman Morris seconded. All were in favor.

Councilman Morris then made the motion to adjourn, and Councilman Eugene Call seconded. All were in favor.
